ORDINANCE NO. 02-002

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CITY OF NEW BERLIN AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, The City of New Berlin entered into a settlement agreement with Texas Heritage Enterprises which allows the City to create an Airport Advisory Committee in coordination with Texas Heritage Enterprises.

WHEREAS, the Texas Heritage Airport and the Texas Heritage Subdivision are within the city limits of the City of New Berlin;

WHEREAS, the Council believes the creation of an Airport Advisory Committee will provide the residents of New Berlin the opportunity to express ideas of mutual benefit.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BERLIN, TEXAS

SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE

The Airport Advisory Committee shall serve as a communications vehicle between the citizens of New Berlin and airfield management to assist the City Council and the airfield management on the following:

- (A) Explore ways to promote the airfield and its proposed museum as a tourist attraction and possible field trip for our school children;
- (B) Propose future events at the airport in conjunction with the City, County, and area municipalities;
- (C) Develop Heritage Airfield support of other City activities and needs.
- (D) Review flight patterns within the scope of Federal Aviation Regulations to enhance the safety of those in air and in the community, and to minimize noise levels produced by the airport;
- (E) Assist the City in development of the surrounding area;
- (F) Assist in the coordination of possible development of an emergency transport of citizens to area hospitals.

SECTION 2. AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- (A) The Committee will consist of six members appointed by the City Council
- (B) At least two members shall be shareholders of Texas Heritage, Inc. or residents of the Texas Heritage subdivision;

- (C) Members will be appointed for a period of two years;
- (D) Committee will meet once every month or as needed.

SECTION 3. REPORT TO COUNCIL

The Airport Advisory Committee members shall serve as advisors only, to City Council. The committee does not have the authority or the responsibility to regulate the airfield or any of its activities.
