

This to rescind the original 76-001

ORDINANCE NUMBER 76 - 001

DECLARING THE NAME OF THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE NEW BERLIN COMMUNITY, TO BE THE CITY OF NEW BERLIN, AND THAT SAID NAME BE AFFIXED TO THE CITY SEAL, CORRESPONDENCE, AND ALL PLACES IDENTIFYING THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the area in which the incorporated city exists has been known for the last 108 years as the New Berlin Community; and

WHEREAS, the proposed name for the area in the petition calling for a vote of the citizens on incorporation was New Berlin; and,

WHEREAS, since that election the name, City of New Berlin has been used by residents of the incorporated area, appeared in print in local Newspapers and used on the radio to identify the area; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare to name the incorporated area, the City of New Berlin; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF NEW BERLIN:

SECTION 1. The name of the area incorporated by a vote of the residents on May 24, 1975, and declared incorporated by the Commissioner's Court, Guadalupe County at a regular meeting June 9, 1975, be the City of New Berlin.

SECTION 2. The name City of New Berlin be affixed to the city seal.

SECTION 3. The name City of New Berlin be affixed to the correspondence and stationery of the city.


SECTION 4. That the name City of New Berlin be affixed to all items that may in the future be used to identify the city.

SECTION 5. Whereas, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation or order, and good government that requires this ordinance to become effective at once; therefore, upon passage of this ordinance by a vote of at least three members of the


Board of Aldermen be effective from and after the date of its passage as made and provided by the general laws of the State of Texas.
