

ORDINANCE NUMBER 76 - 009

WHEREAS, in New Berlin, Texas, an engineering and traffic investigation has been made to determine the maximum, reasonable and prudent speeds on the section of:

Farm to Market Highway 775 from the North City Limits of New Berlin Southerly to the South City Limits, a distance of 6.480 miles approximately.

Farm to Market Highway 2538 from the West City Limits of New Berlin Easterly to the intersection of F.M. 775, a distance of 1.060 miles approximately.

Farm to Market Highway 467 from the Intersection of F.M. 775 Easterly to the East City Limits of New Berlin, a distance of 0.681 miles approximately.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the engineering and traffic investigation that the maximum, reasonable and prudent speeds for the section of highway described above are as shown on the attached plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NEW BERLIN, TEXAS, hereby declares and fixes the maximum, reasonable and prudent speed limits to be as shown on the above plans.


All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
