

ORDINANCE APPROVAL OF NEW ELECTRIC RATES
TO BE CHARGED BY GVEC.

WHEREAS, on August 20, 1980, Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas and with the City of New Berlin a Statement of Intent to increase its rate for each class of electric service; and

WHEREAS, at a hearing at the Public Utility Commission held on November 17, 1980, the parties agreed upon a settlement revising GVEC's proposed rates; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1980, the Hearings Examiner of the Public Utility Commission approved the settlement rates as just and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utility Commission has approved the same rates at its conference on December 18, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. has presented the revised rates proposed to be charged before the City Council of New Berlin in Public Session on January 19, 1981; and

WHEREAS, uniformity of electric rates by GVEC throughout its service area is desirable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of New Berlin that the revised rates proposed by the Guadalupe Valley Electric Cooperative, inc. be, and the same be made effective by GVEC in the city limits at the first billing date following the date of this ordinance.
